## **Upcoming Bible Study**

**“Still Waters” – Lent Bible Study**  
**6 Sundays March 10th- April 14<sup>th</sup>**  
**9:30 a.m. in Fellowship Hall**

The season of Lent is an invitation to turn our hearts to God and to grow in relationship to God. Reflecting on Psalm 23, and using a resource called, “Still Waters” we will be guided through the process of writing our spiritual formation journey, and remembering God’s faithfulness.

In the Moravian Church, this is a practice called “Lebenslauf”, a German word comprised of ‘leben’ for life, and ‘lauf’ for

**path.** This way of reflecting on scripture and our own life journey invites us to reflect on our life with God; where God seems near to us and also times when God seems distant. The outcome is finding hope and assurance through the Psalm and remembering our own stories of faith.

Each participant will receive a “Still Waters” booklet and is asked to bring a notebook or journal to write in. Suggested donation of \$5 per person to cover the cost of the booklet. For more information or to sign up in advance, please see Pastor Linda.

**Please note:** As part of our ongoing commitment to be a safe place for all who gather at Bethany, the doors to the church will be locked on Sunday mornings once the worship service begins.
