## Psalm 54 NRSV

### Prayer for Vindication

**To the leader: with stringed instruments. A Maskil of David, when the Ziphites went and told Saul, “David is in hiding among us.”**

- <sup>1</sup> Save me, O God, by your name,  
and vindicate me by your might.
- <sup>2</sup> Hear my prayer, O God;  
give ear to the words of my mouth.

## James 3: 13 -18 NRSV

### Two Kinds of Wisdom

<sup>13</sup> Who is wise and understanding among you? Show by your good life that your works are done with gentleness born of wisdom. <sup>14</sup> But if you have bitter envy and selfish ambition in your hearts, do not be boastful and false to the truth. <sup>15</sup> Such

wisdom does not come down from above, but is earthly, unspiritual, devilish. <sup>16</sup> For where there is envy and selfish ambition, there will also be disorder and wickedness of every kind. <sup>17</sup> But the wisdom from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, willing to yield, full of mercy and good fruits, without a trace of partiality or hypocrisy. <sup>18</sup> And a harvest of righteousness is sown in peace for those who make peace.

## **Mark 9: 30 - 37 NRSV**

### **Jesus Again Foretells His Death and Resurrection**

<sup>30</sup> They went on from there and passed through Galilee. He did not want anyone to know it; <sup>31</sup> for he was teaching his disciples, saying to them, “The Son of Man is to be betrayed into human hands, and they will kill him, and three days after being killed, he will rise again.” <sup>32</sup> But they did not understand what he was saying and were afraid to ask him.

### **Who Is the Greatest?**

<sup>33</sup> Then they came to Capernaum; and when he was in the house he asked them, “What were you arguing about on the way?” <sup>34</sup> But they were silent, for on the way they had argued with one another who was the greatest. <sup>35</sup> He sat down, called the twelve, and said to them, “Whoever wants to be first must be last of all and servant of all.” <sup>36</sup> Then he took a little child and put it among them; and taking it in his arms, he said to them, <sup>37</sup> “Whoever welcomes one such child in my name welcomes me, and whoever welcomes me welcomes not me but the one who sent me.”

## Joyful Noise for September

The Maxwell James Oskam Foundation was created following the untimely death of my great nephew Maxwell James Oskam. Maxwell passed away on December 26<sup>th</sup>, 2017 as a result of an undiagnosed Neuroblastoma, an extremely rare form of cancer affecting less than 1,000 people per year in the USA. The goal of the Maxwell James Oskam Foundation working along with the “Beat Childhood Cancer” Organization is to help improve the current funding shortcomings associated with the treatment of childhood cancer, while bringing additional awareness to the disease. Here are a few facts you may not be aware of:

-Cancer is diagnosed yearly in 400,000 children worldwide.

-Cancer is the leading cause of death by disease past infancy in the USA.

-Of the billions of dollars allocated by the Government for cancer research, only 4% is allocated for pediatric cancer.

-Since 1950 only 4 drugs have received FDA approval for pediatric cancer. That means there are only 4 drugs to treat 16 types of cancer, which have hundreds of subtypes, to put that in perspective, in 2020 alone, 21 drugs to treat adult cancer were given FDA approval.

For decades doctors have been forced to treat children on a “one size fits all” approach by using adult treatments, watered down to fit the child’s body often times having negative impacts on the mind and body.

Max would have celebrated his 4<sup>th</sup> birthday yesterday. He lived only 99 days. Through the Maxwell James Oskam Foundation, the Oskams have dedicated themselves to bringing awareness to Childhood cancer in an attempt to prevent other families from facing the same tragedy that sadly had to experience. Please give what you can to help in the fight against Childhood Cancer.

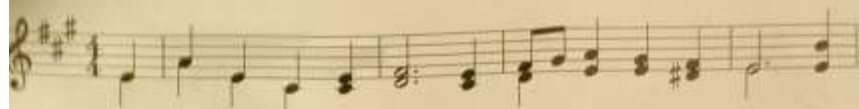

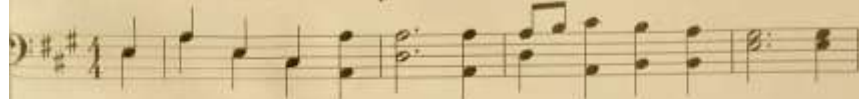

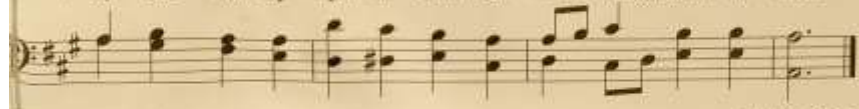
