A note from our Music Director:

As the summer season comes to a close, I cannot express the joy that I have received from those participants in Bethany's Music Ministry. The variety of worship music has



been incredible thanks to those willing to share their time and talents. The Handbell Choir has been the consistent backbone of the program since in-person worship began in July of 2020. Yet, despite all that, a piece of our musical family has been missing and the time has come to bring the singing of anthems back to our Sunday services.

After church on Sunday August 22nd, members of the Handbell and Chancel

Choir met to discuss plans for the fall. Absent members had personal conversations with me prior to the meeting. This is the result of our interaction:

The HANDBELL CHOIR will keep their 5:30 - 6:30 pm rehearsal time. For the next two months they will rehearse on an every other week schedule (one necessary exception). They will play at worship Sunday September 26 and October 24th upstairs in our sanctuary. We will NOT go back to two on a handbell table at this time. Playing configurations will be fluid according to the pieces played. Handbells will be kept in their individual boxes per ringer to avoid office congestion. We will refrain from wearing robes.

The CHANCEL CHOIR will have their first rehearsal on September 1st. Our new rehearsal time is from 7:00 to 8:00 pm on Wednesdays, following the Handbell Choir. We will observe the on/off schedule of the Handbell Choir. We will social distance and wear masks. We will sit with our "family/friend circle" in the sanctuary and come forward to sing. We will forego robes for the time being. Chancel Choir will now need to "operate" in the same manner of the Handbell Choir, meaning that members must give me their schedules as to when rehearsals or Sunday worship will be missed. Because of our size and numbers on a part, that information is crucial for anthem planning and execution. At least six weeks in advance is preferable, and yes, things do come up, but we want to give our best at worship. Finally, since I want to provide a safe and healthy rehearsal experience, I ask this of both the Handbell and Chancel Choirs...if you are sick or have symptoms of Covid, please call me and stay home. We need to protect our choir family (and their families) and care for each other. I promise to do my part to make our anthems "work" as best as our circumstances allow. As we move closer to the end of the year, we will re-examine our rehearsal schedule, but for now it is Handbells 5:30-6:30 pm and Chancel Choir 7:00 - 8:00 pm on Wednesdays September 1st and 22nd and October 6th and 20th.

Many thanks for your cooperation and input, and please know that we will continue to use our talented instrumentalists during our worship services as well as our Handbell and Chancel Choirs. I will coordinate rehearsals with participants at their convenience. We ask God to bless us as we strive to praise Him with our voices and instruments.

Joyful Noise for September

September Joyful Noise on September 19th will be to benefit the Maxwell James Oskam Foundation. This foundation was started after 99-day old Max died from an undiagnosed neuroblastoma. Paula and Todd Oskam found a way to channel their grief into something positive in hopes of raising awareness of pediatric cancer. Here are some unbelievable facts about this terrible disease.

- * 400,00 children 19 and under are diagnosed with cancer
- * Cancer is the leading cause of death last infancy for U.S. Kids
- *ONLY 4% of the billions of government dollars is allocated to pediatric cancer
- *Since 1950 only 4 drugs have been FAR approved for pediatric cancer
- * In 2020 alone 21 drugs were FDA approved for adult cancer

If Max had been diagnosed, he would have likely been treated with one-size-fits-all, adult cancer drugs watered down to the weight of a child. This is a cause near and dear to my heart. I never met Max and I have grieved with my niece Paula and her family. I hope you will help us raise money and awareness for this wonderful foundation. Help us beat pediatric cancer. Maxwell's 4th birthday is September 18. Please help me give him a great present!
