## Bethlehem Emergency Shelter

Can you believe it is September already? Another summer has flown by and fall is quickly approaching and that means another season of sheltering our homeless neighbors will begin at the Bethlehem Emergency Sheltering and WE NEED YOU! Bethany UCC has played an integral part in volunteering at BES for years and we look forward to continuing that tradition again this year,

but we cannot do it without our faithful volunteers. While we do not yet know what this season holds, we do know that we will need both male and female volunteers to assist with registration, preparing the dinner meal, clean up and showers.

If you were not already aware, BES is a faith-based partnership that provides a hot meal, the opportunity for a shower, a bed and a safe environment for our homeless neighbors to shelter during the coldest months of the year. In addition, BES also works with their clients to help them find permanent housing as well as food stamps, Medicaid/Medicare, VA benefits and other services as necessary. BES plays a very important role in our community through the kindness, generosity and assistance of hundreds of volunteers each season.

It is my sincere hope that the good people of Bethany UCC will assist BES this year in their continued mission. If you have the gift of cooking and have a recipe you would like to share, join us in preparing the meal! If you like to clean, we have opportunities in the kitchen. If you like to meet new people and greet them with a smile, then registration or shower monitoring is for you. While I understand that people are busy and may not have the time to physically volunteer, monetary donations are also welcome and if you are a baker at heart, a donated dessert for the meal is always appreciated. The clients always LOVE the homemade desserts and truly appreciate the volunteers caring for them!

I have had the opportunity to speak to many clients at the shelter over the years and have learned that homelessness does not discriminate and can happen to anyone, at any time, for any reason. God has made each one of us special and unique in our own way and has provided us with His special gifts to use for His kingdom.
