

# **Scriptures**

Psalm 31: 9 - 16 NRSV

- <sup>9</sup> Be gracious to me, O LORD, for I am in distress; my eye wastes away from grief, my soul and body also.
- <sup>10</sup> For my life is spent with sorrow and my years with sighing;

my strength fails because of my misery,

and my bones waste away.

- <sup>11</sup> I am the scorn of all my adversaries, a horror to my neighbors,

### Mark 14: 1 - 9 NRSV

14 It was two days before the Passover and the Festival of Unleavened Bread. The chief priests and the scribes were looking for a way to arrest Jesus by stealth and kill him, <sup>2</sup> for they said, "Not during the festival, or there may be a riot among the people." While he was at Bethany in the house of Simon the leper, as he sat at the table, a woman came with an alabaster jar of very costly ointment of nard, and she broke open the iar and poured the ointment on his head. <sup>4</sup> But some were there who said to one another in anger, "Why was the ointment wasted in this way? 5 For this ointment could have been sold for more than three hundred denarii and the money given to the poor." And they scolded her. <sup>6</sup> But Jesus said, "Let her alone; why do you trouble her? She has performed a good service for me. <sup>7</sup> For you always have the poor with you, and you can show kindness to them whenever you wish, but you will not always have me. 8 She has done what she could; she has anointed my body beforehand for its burial. <sup>9</sup> Truly I tell you, wherever the good news is proclaimed in the whole world, what she has done will be told in remembrance of her."


