From Pastor Dave

The gospels are written as witnesses to the redemptive, renewing, resurrecting power of God demonstrated by Jesus. Every healing story is a resurrection story. Every telling about a blind man seeing and lame man walking is a resurrection story. But even more, Jesus' radical hospitality for those who were outcasts in society—the



sick, the lepers, the poor, the tax collectors and women— Jesus' radical hospitality to those folks, inviting them to be part of his followers, that too is a resurrection story.

But we can so easily miss them. And I think that one of the reasons that we don't see or interpret God's redemptive power in our midst is that we missed one of the biggest examples of this action in the Bible. Think about first century Middle-Eastern culture. Or don't even go back to the first century. Think about what you have seen and heard about social power and social class among people in places like Iraq or Iran or Syria or Afghanistan. Who are the silent ones, the powerless ones, the cover-up ones? They are the women. And yet, who is it that all four of the gospel writers use as the ones who first learn about God's resurrecting power. The message comes to the women.

Be sure to join in worship during the weeks of March, the season of Lent, to hear more about the stories of the people whom Jesus meets on his way to the cross. And be sure to join in worship on Easter Sunday when we'll hear more Jesus and the women at the tomb, the ones who first learn of the resurrecting power of God.

As I sat in the eye doctor's waiting room the other day, I saw posters of eyes on all the walls. Being in a meditative mood, I couldn't help but think of one of our congregational responses" Open Our Eyes". The opening words are "Open our eyes, Lord, we want to see Jesus." It got me to thinking that if we want to see Jesus, Jesus would probably want to see us in return. I wonder what He would see. My guess is that He would see a mixed bag of good and not so good behavior. During the season of Lent, we are supposed to work on those not so good aspects of our daily lives. Hopefully we all will spend some quality time with Him in prayer, asking for help to be a better follower of the one that we say we love. The music throughout the month of March is being prepared to help each worshipper feel a closeness to our Savior. Each week will have special music prepared by our choirs and talented Bethany worshippers. Continuing our Lenten journey to Palm Sunday, Holy Week, and Easter we strive to enhance your worship experience during this most holy time of the church year.

Rehearsals for the Handbell and Chancel choirs will be held on March 13th and March 27th. There will be an additional rehearsal for the Chancel Choir on March 20th. The Brass Quartet will rehearse at 6:30 on March 27th. All other instrumental rehearsals will take place at arranged times.
